An Awards Ceremony to recognize and present Marine Sylvester McIntosh the Silver Star for his act of bravery in Vietnam was held at 1300 hours, 30 January 2016 on Veterans Memorial Island Sanctuary in Vero Beach. Ron Brooks, Dwight Harris, John Harris; and Commandant	Eagle Scout Liaison History: In 1918, the Secretary of Navy allowed women to enroll for clerical duty in the Marine Corps. Officially, Opha Mae
Kon Brooks, Dwight Harris, John Harris, and Commandant Mike Ambrosino of Jack Ivey League along with one additional member of their Detachment participated in a Marine Corps League Color Guard as part of the ceremony. Vic Diaz and John Michael Mathews also participated in the ceremony. Mike Bodnar, Sue Brooks, Dennis Caffrey, Mike Maguire, Ernie Miller, Tim Nightingale, Yank Yannetelli and members of the Jack Ivy and Barefoot Bay Detachments attended.	Johnson is credited as the first woman Marine. Johnson enrolled for service on August 13, 1918; during that year some 300 women first entered the Marine Corps to take over stateside clerical duties from battle-ready Marines who were needed overseas. June 12th, 1948, Congress passed the Women's Armed Services Integration Act and made women a permanent part of the regular Marine Corps. By 1975, the Corps approved the assignment of women to all occupational fields except infantry, artillery, and armor and pilot/air crew.
