The Detachment participated in the Veterans Day ceremony on November 10. Commandant Dwight Harris manned the Ships Bell and a Color Guard represented the Detachment with Ron Brooks, Dennis Caffrey, Paul Netzel and Sue Brooks as participants. 	Just before 8 a.m. on December 7, 1941, hundreds of Japanese fighter planes attacked the American naval base at Pearl Harbor near Honolulu, Hawaii. The barrage lasted just two hours, but it was devastating: The Japanese managed to destroy nearly 20 American naval vessels, including eight enormous battleships, and almost 200 airplanes. More than 2,000 American soldiers and sailors died in the attack, and another 1,000 were wounded. The day after the assault, President Franklin D. Roosevelt asked Congress to declare war on Japan; Congress approved his declaration with just one dissenting vote. Japanese allies, Germany and Italy,
